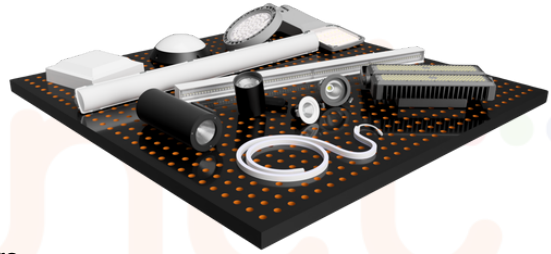

Free Removal & Recycling on Lighting Projects

When using Lightnet luminaires in Lighting Projects, **Lightnet** takes responsibility for the **removal, recycling, and compliant disposal** of the existing luminaires — **at no additional cost**.

Why This Matters

Electronic waste is one of the fastest-growing waste streams. Regulations now require that lighting manufacturers take responsibility for products they place on the market once those products reach end-of-life.

Manufacturer Responsibility (EPR)

Under **Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR)** regulations, manufacturers and importers must report waste streams to the **Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE)** and ensure responsible recycling beyond the product's usable life.

Lightnet fully complies with this requirement.

How to Enquire

When planning a retrofit or upgrade, speak to your **Lightnet sales representative** with the following information:

- Products required and quantities
- Existing luminaires to be replaced
- Estimated quantities of removed fittings

How It Works

- **Lightnet** supplies luminaires at standard rates
- An **EPR fee of R0.00** is shown on the invoice
- This notifies the **ERA (E-Waste Recycling Authority)** to arrange collection of removed luminaires

Collection & Disposal

Before and After removal, notify **Lightnet** and provide:

- Luminaire types
- Quantities
- Approximate weights and dimensions

ERA will manage collection and disposal in full compliance with South African regulations.

Terms & Conditions

- Disposal quantities must reasonably match the number of **Lightnet** luminaires supplied
- Example: Supplying 10 **Lightnet** luminaires does not qualify for disposal of 50 old fittings
- Final eligibility is assessed based on project scope and replacement products
